Subj: Conduct of Morning Assembly

d.	1x Iqbal poetic verse with translation (relating to education, Khudi (ego), hard work, nationalism, moral values)	2 Mins	1
e.	National & International News (non-conflicting, non-aggressive, non-violent news)	2 Mins	1
f.	Knowing Pakistan Loving Pakistan (relating to Pakistan visiting places, national and international achievements of Pakistan, Pakistani heroes etc)	2 Mins	1
g.	Thought of the day (Reformative)	1 Min	1
h.	Bache ki Dua (لب پہ آتی ہے دعا بن کے تمنا میری) 4x students will be detailed to recite the dua on the stage (all students in assembly will recite)	3 Min	4
i.	Playing National Anthem (all students, teaching and non-teaching staff will recite)	1.5 Min	All participants
j.	Understanding of National Anthem (explanation of anthem verses with core hidden message)	Once in a Month	1
k.	Last Sermon (Khutba e Hujja Tul Vida) (explanation with relationship to existing life practices)	Once in a Month	1
